Dear CSDNB families,

We hope you are all staying safe and healthy. The following updates are from Superintendent Nancy Sarra.

- We will be donating the district's Personal Protection Equipment (PPEs) including N95 face masks and gloves to our local hospitals today. Thank you CSDNB Nurses for taking the lead on this!
- We have heard from 9,000 out of 10,000 families who answered our two-question survey: Do you have access to WiFi? Do you have a learning device in your home such as a tablet, laptop computer, desktop computer or Chromebook? Our school secretaries and family school liaisons will be calling those 1,000 families who have not responded over the next two days. In order to help you we MUST hear from you. If you have not yet answered the survey and do not get a phone call by Thursday, please email your building principal to answer the survey.
- Videos will be posted on our Facebook page and website, www.csdnb.org, to help parents assist their child in logging onto Google classroom. We realize it can be very difficult for families to share devices and will also be posting guidance on how to utilize a smart television, Xbox, or PlayStation to access Google Classroom and other online resources.
- Reminder: We must have your most updated address and working phone numbers. We plan to begin Interim Learning next Monday, March 30. Students will be expected to log into Google classroom. All families should receive a letter in the mail this week with directions and personal login information if you haven't already. This letter includes important information for our parent portal as well.
- Ensure your family is enforcing the social distancing rules and reducing the number of people you and your child are coming in contact with. We must think beyond ourselves to ensure we are helping to reduce the spread of COVID 19 for everyone.
