Dear CSDNB families,

Our primary goal is to ensure all of our students, their families, and our staff remain healthy and safe throughout this time. That is the most important thing to all of us. Three weeks ago, we began reaching out to all families in our district. We have consistently messaged on Facebook, robocalls, our home page, and through home mailings that families must be sure that your child's school has updated addresses and updated phone contacts.

In a conference call today with the State Department of Education, we were notified that we have entered the peak period which may last up to, and beyond, April 11. It is critically important that all of us Stay Home and Stay Safe as best we can. Because of this we will not be opening our buildings to any families during this time. Our essential staff will be in the buildings but will not be opening the doors to any families. If you need to get in touch with your building principal, please call your school's main office. We have our building secretaries working from home and answering their school's line. If you are still in need of a Chromebook or did not pick up your child's medication during the last two weeks, call the office and let them know. We are in continuous communication with the Department of Public Health as well as the State Department of Education and will assess the situation on April 11, 2020 as to whether or not families can come in at that time.

We care deeply about our students but know that they are in good hands with you. Stay safe, stay home and be well.
