Review New Position Request for 1.0 FTE Specialized Classroom Management Trainer - Districtwide

The Specialized Classroom Management (SCM)Trainer will work with the Pupil Services Department and the administrators of the self-contained behavioral programs to implement and support behavior management and modification in a structured, coordinated manner. This position is responsible for overseeing and leading implementation of social skills teaching in self-contained behavioral programs. This position will represent the school district and maintain positive relationships with Boy's Town to sustain a partnership that furthers the mission of the district and community. The funding source will be local budget and the cost for this 12-month position is estimated to be 59,651.80 per year. Document needs to be updated and signed by personnel and finance department.

The Personnel Committee recommended to add the new position request for (1.0) Specialized Classroom Management Trainer Campus Safety Officers districtwide to the Board's new business agenda for the next regular meeting in January.
