Board Policy Statement

1351.00 – Free Admission for Honored and/or Wounded Veterans

Approved on August 17, 1992

In recognition of those veterans who have served in the armed services of this country and who have been cited for bravery and valor and/or wounded during military combat, the New Britain School District authorizes honored and/or wounded veterans to be eligible for free general admissions to school district activities if he/she is a resident of New Britain who has received and of the following military commendations for distinguished service in the armed forces of the United States:

- Congressional Medal of Honor
- Distinguished Service Cross
- Silver Star
- Distinguished Flying Cross with “V” device
- Bronze Star with “V” device
- Air Medal with “V” device
- Army Commendation Medal with “V” device
- Navy Cross
- Legion of Merit with “V” device
- Air Force Cross with “V” device
- Distinguished Service Medal with “V” device
- Airman’s Medal with “V” device
- Marine Corps Medal with “V” device
- Purple Heart

Such veteran shall possess and show a card issued by the Veteran’s Commission of the City of New Britain identifying him/her to be a decorated veteran together with some other form of identification, which contains a photograph, such as, but not limited to, a driver's license.
