## **2020 BEFORE SCHOOL, AFTER SCHOOL & REMOTE LEARNING CARE HYBRID MODEL FOR GRADES K-5<sup>TH</sup> PROVIDED BY THE NEW BRITAIN YMCA**

### **Why the Y?**

As a partner with the Consolidated School District of New Britain, the YMCA is proud to offer program options to assist with this school year's *Hybrid model for those families that are in need of before school, after school, and "remote learning" care.* Our well-trained and qualified staff will engage the children in a wide variety of activities that include sports, arts and crafts, team building activities, outdoor time, cooperative games and more. Our programs focus on the fundamentals of the YMCA core values of Caring, Honesty, Respect and Responsibility. All staff are first aid, CPR, & administration of medication certified.

### **Before & After School Care:**

**Before & after school care is offered for in-school learning days:**

Cohort A = Monday & Tuesday

Cohort B = Thursday & Friday

**In the following schools both before & after school care is offered:**

Lincoln, Vance, Smith, Smalley, Northend, Gaffney, Jefferson, Holmes, & Chamberlain.

**\*For Diloreto School- only the after school program is offered.**

**2-day AM (Before) Care (on Cohort "in school learning days only"):**

\$16 per week /per child

- Starts at 7:00 a.m. until school begins
- Program cancelled when there's a 2hr. delay of school
- Minimum of 10 students enrolled for program to run.
- Offered in all schools except Diloreto.
- Additional \$24/day fee if all day care is needed for a HEAT DAY

**2-day PM (After) Care (on Cohort "in school learning days only")**

\$24 per week/per child

- Starts at school dismissal and ends at 5:30pm
- Minimum of 10 students enrolled for program to run.
- Offered in all schools including Diloreto.
- Additional \$16/day fee if all day care is needed for a HEAT DAY

### **Remote Learning Care:**

Remote Learning care is being offered to families who need a daycare option on the days that their student's Cohort has a scheduled "remote learning" day or on Wednesdays when all students are remote learning.

Cohort A = Thursday & Friday

Cohort B = Monday & Tuesday

Wednesday = Available to all

**2-day Remote Learning Care (Mon. & Tues. or Thurs & Fri.)**

\$48 per week /per child

- Starts at 9:00 AM until school ends at 3:10PM
- Minimum of 10 students enrolled for program to run.
- Location –Smalley or Chamberlain –choose at registration.

**Wednesday – ALL DAY Remote Learning Care**

\$40 per week /per child

- Starts at 7:00AM until 5:00PM
- Minimum of 10 students enrolled for program to run.
- Location –Smalley or Chamberlain – choose at registration.

### **Additional Offerings:**

- On scheduled "no school" days (not including major holidays) we offer **Fun Days** at the YMCA facility at 50 High St. in New Britain, at an additional cost of \$40 per day/per child. **Time is from 7am-5pm.** Details & registration are available two weeks prior to the no school day.
- **In the event that the district cancels school due to extreme HEAT in the early fall months, we will still be offering our programs for those registered for before or after school. However the length of care will now be extended for the entire day, for an additional fee.**
- Take advantage of our **Snow Day Club** - which offers care at the YMCA, at an additional cost, on those days when school is cancelled due to inclement weather. Information is available by Nov. 1<sup>st</sup>.

### **Registration Information:**

- **REGISTRATION BEGINS Aug. 19<sup>th</sup>**
- To register please complete the required registration packet (1 per child). Registration packet is available online at [www.nbbyymca.org](http://www.nbbyymca.org) or in person at the YMCA. Bring the completed packet and a current copy of the child's physical form with immunization records to the New Britain YMCA, 50 High St. **\*NEW\* Register online at [nbbyymca.org](http://nbbyymca.org)**
- At the time of registration, the child must become a Program Member of the Y (\$34/per child). There is also a one-time registration fee required (\$30 per child).
- Weekly payments are required by auto-draft to a credit/debit card or bank account. Payments are scheduled 1 week in advance of care.
- **Care4Kids is accepted. Financial Aid is available.**
