\$40 per week /per child, from 7:00-9:00AM

**Option #2: AM Out-of School Care ( for students in AM Pre-K)**

\$130 per week/per child, from 11AM-5:30PM

**Option #3: After Care (for students in Full Day or PM Pre-K)**

\$60 per week/per child, from 2:00PM-5:30PM

**Option #4: PM Out-of School Care (for students in PM Pre-K)**

\$110 per week/per child, from 7:00AM-12:30PM
